Help us make your profile perfect

Collexis can build great expertise profiles, but the only one who can make your profile "perfect" is you. Please send us a note with any additions or deletions from your list of authored publications to perfectprofiles@collexis.com. Or, if you prefer, you can register and update your own profile through our Profiling Wizard at www.biomedexperts.com. Your registration and use of the site is free. The changes you make to your BiomedExperts profile will be propagated to the JHU-specific applications on a quarterly basis in conjunction with the profiles of new JHU scientists being added to the system.

Why are profiles great, but not perfect?

Collexis uses a complex process to build high-quality research profiles. The first part of our process is automated and set up to ensure precise assignment of PubMed paper citations to their authors. However, this very precise process errs on the side of not assigning some papers. Hence, your profile may be incomplete. So Collexis has a second process of quality assurance by trained quality management professionals. However, this process (which is human in nature) can sometimes do the reverse – assign a PubMed paper to you that does not belong. Although this two step approach is a best-in-class industry practice, it still is not perfect and can only be corrected with your help.

If you have PubMed papers missing in your profile, or you have papers which you would like to have removed, please send an email to perfectprofiles@collexis.com with the relevant PubMed IDs (PMIDs) of the papers in question. Not only will your update help us now, but it will also help ensure that future documents are routed to your profile with a higher degree of confidence.
